Physician-assisted Suicide and Euthanasia: Please be assured that the Canadian Bishops view this issue with the utmost gravity and concern. The President of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (Most Reverend Douglas Crosby, Diocese of Hamilton) and Cardinal Thomas Collins, Archdiocese of Toronto have written to both the Minister of Justice and the Attorney General of Canada, and the Minister of Health regarding this issue. Similarly they have requested to appear before the Special Joint Committee on Physician-Assisted Dying, a body charged with developing appropriate legislation for the country to regulate doctor assisted suicide. It is also important to recall that the Church's long-standing position has been unequivocal in supporting and defending life from conception to natural death.
