POPE FRANCIS ASKED THE FAITHFUL AND ALL PERSONS OF GOOD WILL to receive his new Encyclical letter on the care of creation with open hearts. Pope Francis said, "Tomorrow, as you know, the Encyclical on the care of the 'common house' that is creation will be published." Pope Francis went on to say, "Our 'house' is being ruined, and that hurts everyone, especially the poorest among us." "I invite all to welcome with an open spirit this document, which places itself in the line of the Church's social doctrine." The encyclical's name—**Laudato si (Praised Be To You)**—is a title reflecting St. Francis' Canticle of the Sun, a hymn of praise to God for His creations, written in 1224. There is a strangely simple theme to this Sunday: that God has power over the forces of nature, because he created them in the first place. This is what the first reading tells us, and also what the gospel shows us, when Jesus "rebukes the wind". This tells us something about Jesus (*that he is God made man*), and also something about our faith. It's also interesting that the disciples re-act to this miracle with fear and awe ☹ as if their minds were suddenly opened to a reality they had not realized before. They had chosen to follow the Christ who had called them, but we see their understanding of who he is growing and developing. Perhaps this is of comfort to us, as we see our relationship with the Lord who controls the waters grow and develop, and alerts us to be ready for the surprises that following the Lord can bring.




